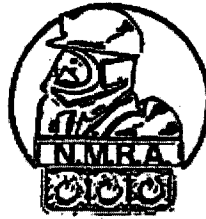

APPLICANTS: 2012 NMRA Post 5 Mine Rescue, First Aid, Bench, and Preshift Contest

We are pleased to announce that this year's NMRA Post 5 Mine Rescue Contest. The contest will be held August 15-16, 2012, at Mylan Park in Morgantown, West Virginia.

Attached are blank registration forms for the 2012 NMRA Post 5 Mine Rescue, First Aid, Bench, and Preshift Contests. Please print or type the appropriate information on the registration form. All registration forms and fees are due to be sent in by July 1, 2012.

Teams may enter as many participants as they wish. Each participant may compete in any or all of the competitions. Registration fees are as follows:

Mine Rescue	\$400 (Per Team)
First Aid Team.....	\$175 (Per Contestant)
Bench Participant.....	\$125 (Per Contestant)
Preshift Participant	\$125 (Per Contestant)
Awards Banquet Tickets.....	\$30 (Per Person)
Golf Outing.....	\$75 (Per Person)

Lunch will also be provided to all participants, including spectators, at no cost during the first day of competition. Vendors will be available to purchase food the second day of the competition but will not be provided free.

Please note that the Mine Rescue Contest may be limited to as few as 42 teams. Entry will be awarded in the order in which registration forms are received. Payment of the registration fees must accompany the two-page registration form when submitted. Fee payment must be in the form of a check made payable to the **NMRA Post 5**. The Mine Rescue Competitions will be held Wednesday, August 15, 2012, beginning at 8:00 a.m. The First Aid, Preshift, and Bench Competitions will be held on Thursday, August 16, 2012, beginning at 8:00 a.m. The

Awards Banquet will be held on Thursday, August 16, at 6:00 p.m. at the Mylan Park Hazel and J W Ruby Community Center.

There will be a scramble golf outing on Tuesday, August 14, beginning at 1:00 p.m. at the Pines Country Club. Additional information and a separate registration form for this event are also attached. Checks for the golf outing must be payable to NMRA Post 5 and must be separate from the registration/banquet fees.

Teams will be permitted to unload and set up their equipment in the Lock-up area (Mylan Park Hazel and J W Ruby Community Center) between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 14.

Cell phones or other electronic devices are strictly forbidden in the Lock-up areas on the days of competition. Lock-up for all contests will start at 6:30 a.m. during both days of competition. Teams will be expected to take all equipment and personal belongings with them as they exit the Lock-up for competition.

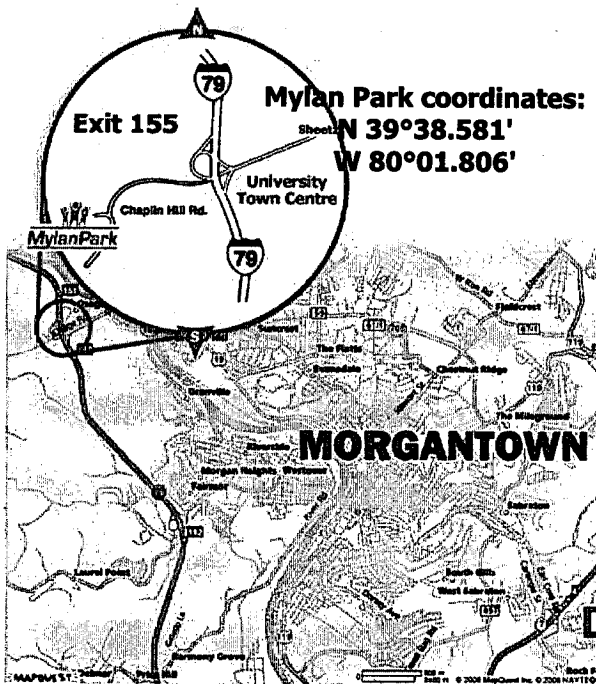

Directions To Mylan Park

I-79 from the North - Pennsylvania: Take Exit 155 (US-19 / WV-7 – West Virginia University) and turn right on Chaplin Hill Road. The Mylan Park South Gate entrance is 1.7 miles on the right.

I-79 from the South - Clarksburg/Fairmont/Charleston: Take Exit 155 (US-19 / WV-7 – West Virginia University) and turn left on Chaplin Hill Road. The Mylan Park South Gate entrance is 1.8 miles on the right.

I-68 from the East – Cheat Lake/Preston County/Maryland: When I-68 ends at I-79, take I-79 North to Exit 155. At that exit, turn left on Chaplin Hill Road for 1.8 miles. The South Gate entrance to Mylan Park is on the right.

From Morgantown via US-19/WV-7: Departing Morgantown on US-19 North or WV-7 West, cross the Monongahela River and at the next stop light (beside Sheetz), continue up the hill toward I-79 past the entrance to University Town Centre. Go under I-79 and stay on Chaplin Hill Road for 1.7 miles to the Mylan Park South Gate entrance on the right.

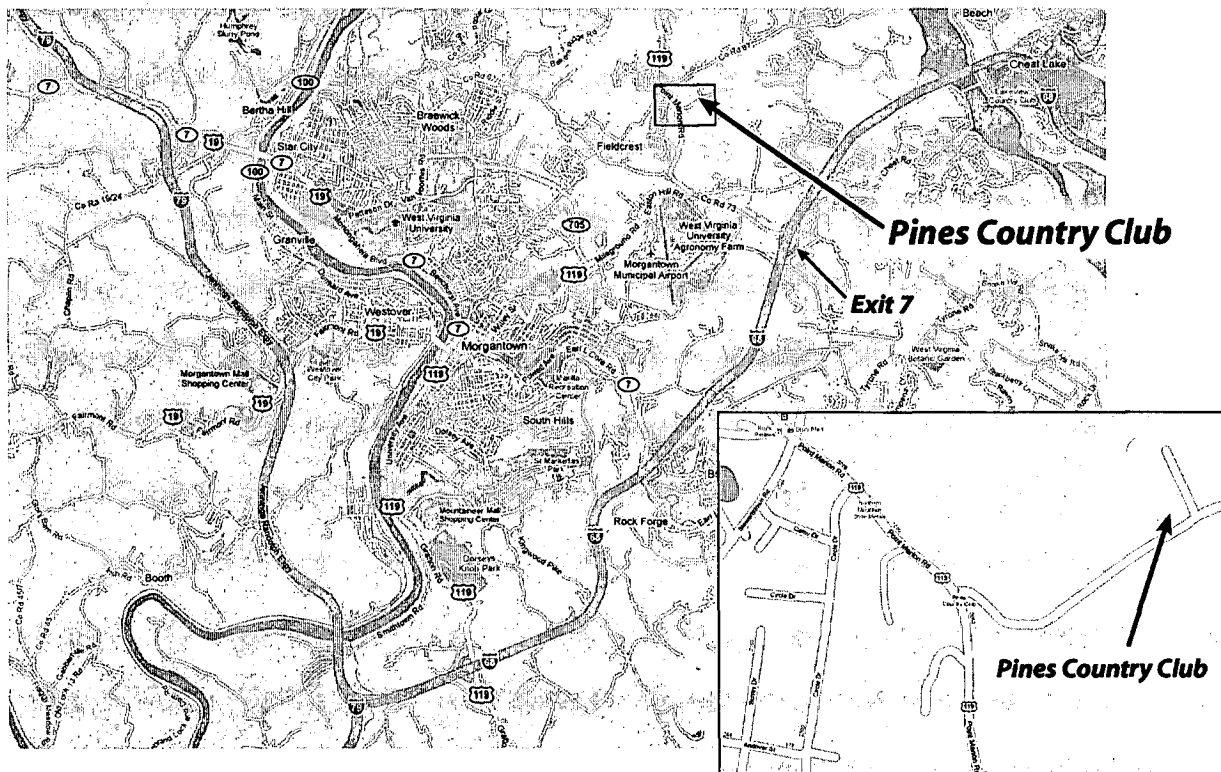
