STATEMENT

Thanks for answering our call for help. You are located underground at the fresh air base of the Knott #1 Mines. We had a 4 man crew go in on 3rd shift to finish the last few cuts of the #3 section. Second shift liked just a little cutting out so the third shift crew was going to finish cutting out and prepare the unit to move to the new set-up. At 2 a.m. the foreman called out for help they had a problem. Since his call we have been unable to make contact with anyone on the section. The 3rd shift foreman made it almost to section but encountered bad top and low O2. We have created a fresh air base, we need you to explore and help find our missing miners. The Fan is an exhausting fan with intake coming up the #2 entry and returning out #1 and #3 entries. The Mine map is not up to date. That is all the information we have at this time. State and Federal agencies have been notified and we have back up teams here to assist.

WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS

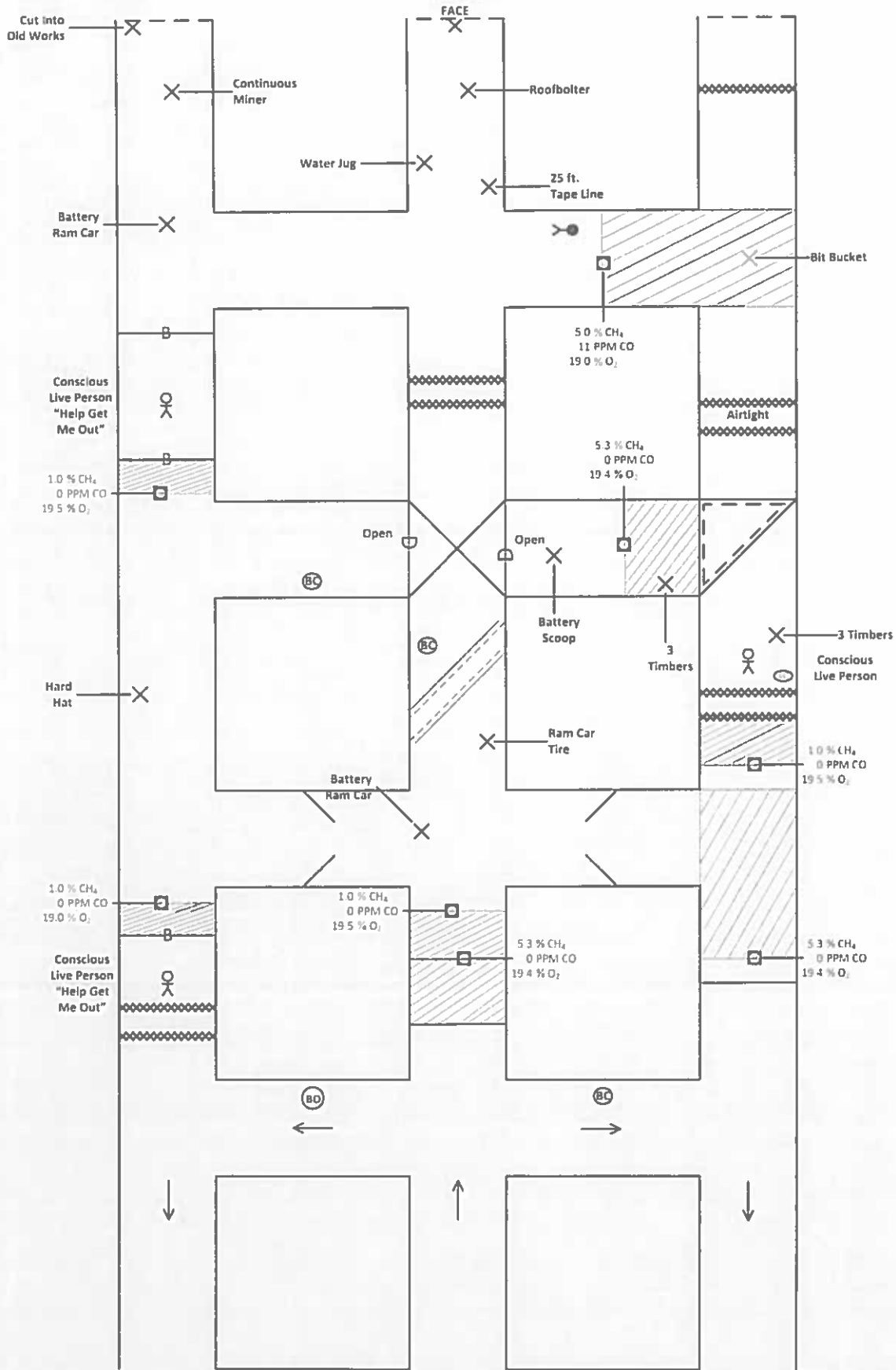
Explore all areas of mine that can be done safely.

Account for all missing miners and bring survivors to fresh air base.

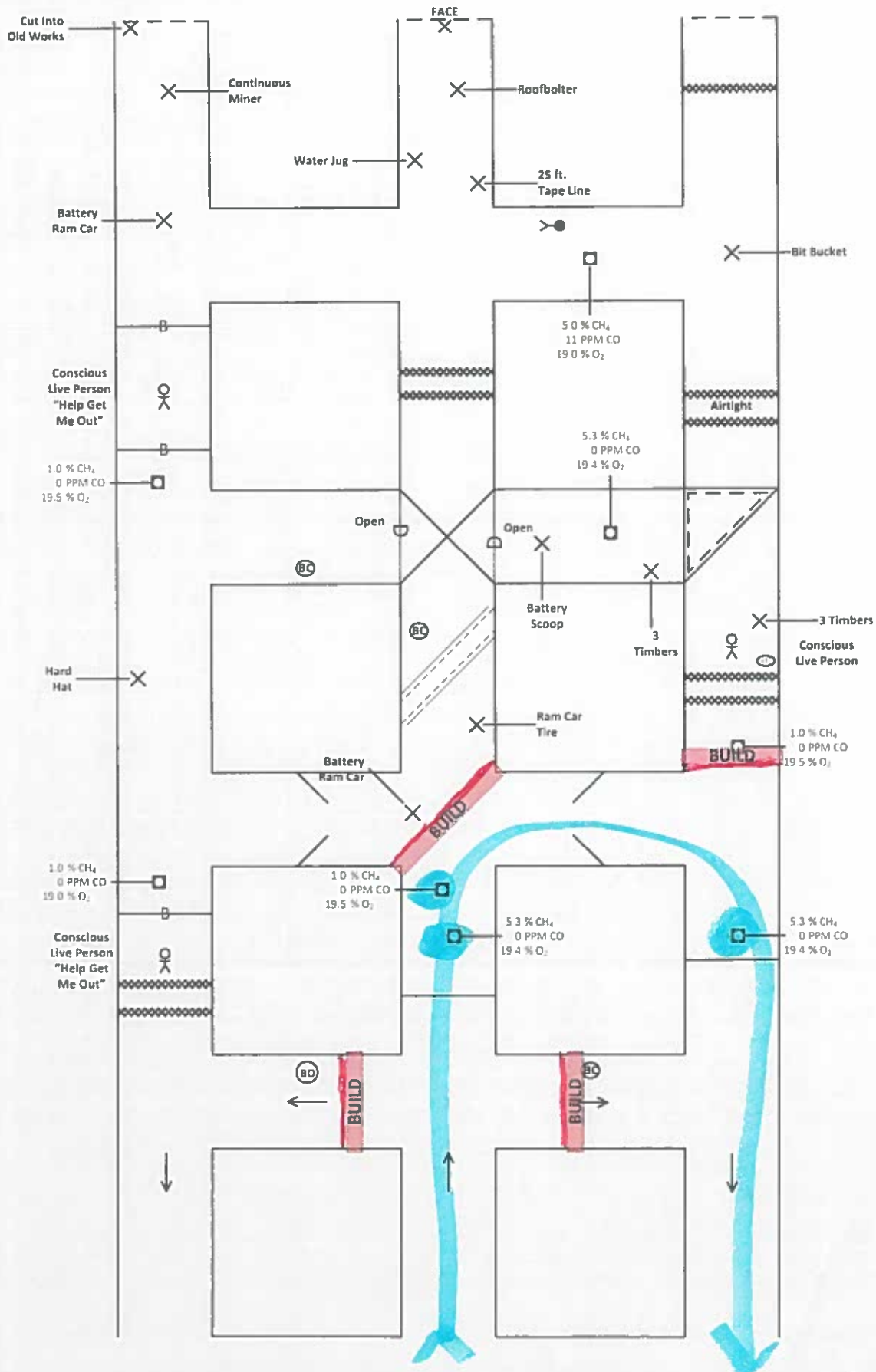
2022 HARLAN SAFETY DAYS – EXTENT OF GAS
