## DAY 2 COMPETITION STATEMENT

**Thanks for responding to our call for help. You are located at the fresh air base on the #1 section at the Big Orange # 2 mine. At 3 am we had a four man crew enter the mine to do maintenance on the #2 section. At 3:30 am the lead man went to the mechanic shack to pick up some parts but when he returned to the section he was unable to make contact with the remaining miners due to unsafe roof and low O<sub>2</sub>. He established the fresh air base and returned to the surface. State and Federal have been notified and are on scene along with back up mine rescue teams. This is all the information we have at this time. Please help find our missing miners. Thanks and good luck.**

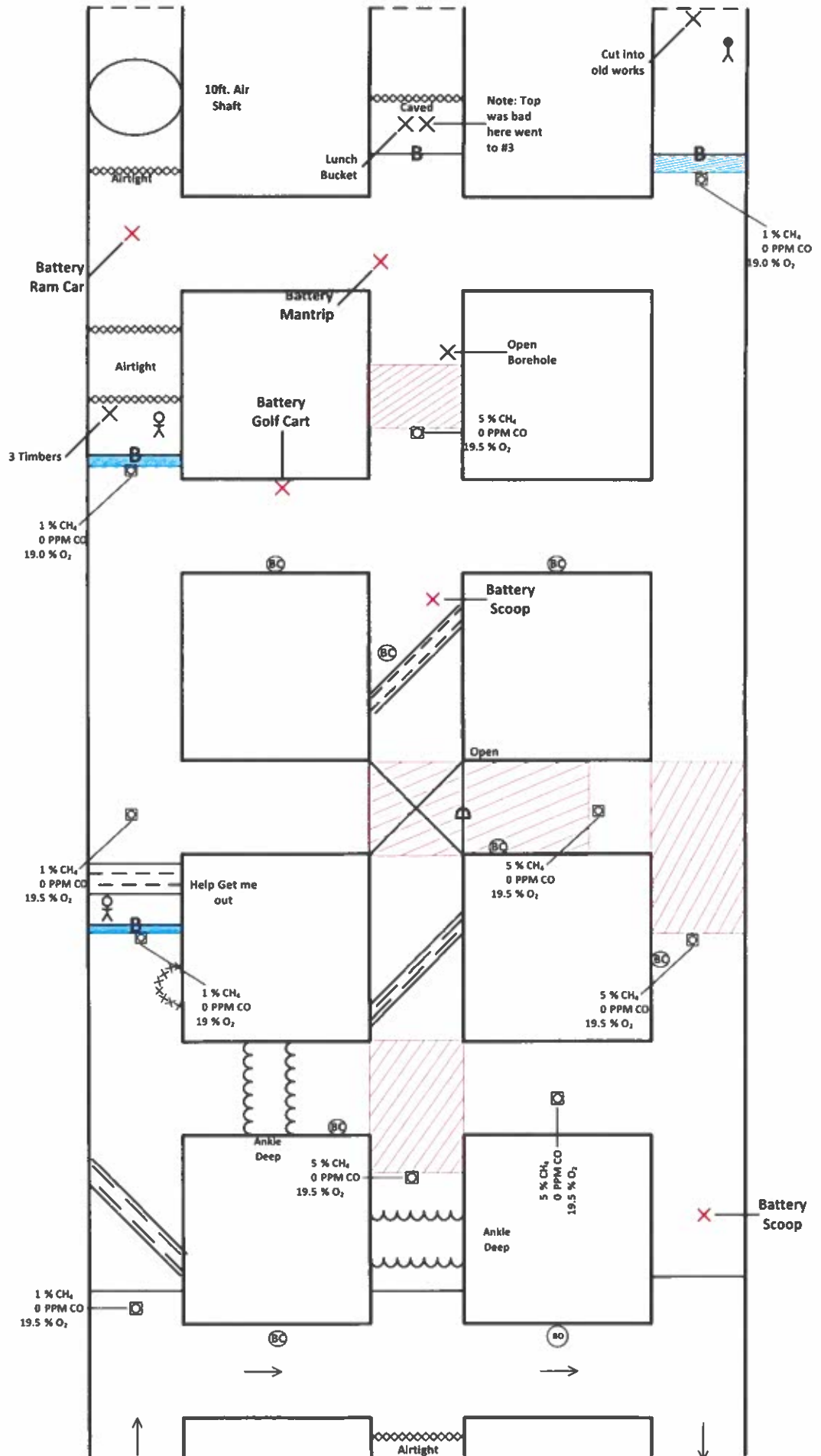
**EXPLORE THE ENTIRE MINE IF SAFE TO DO SO.**

**THE MINE MAP IS NOT UP TO DATE.**

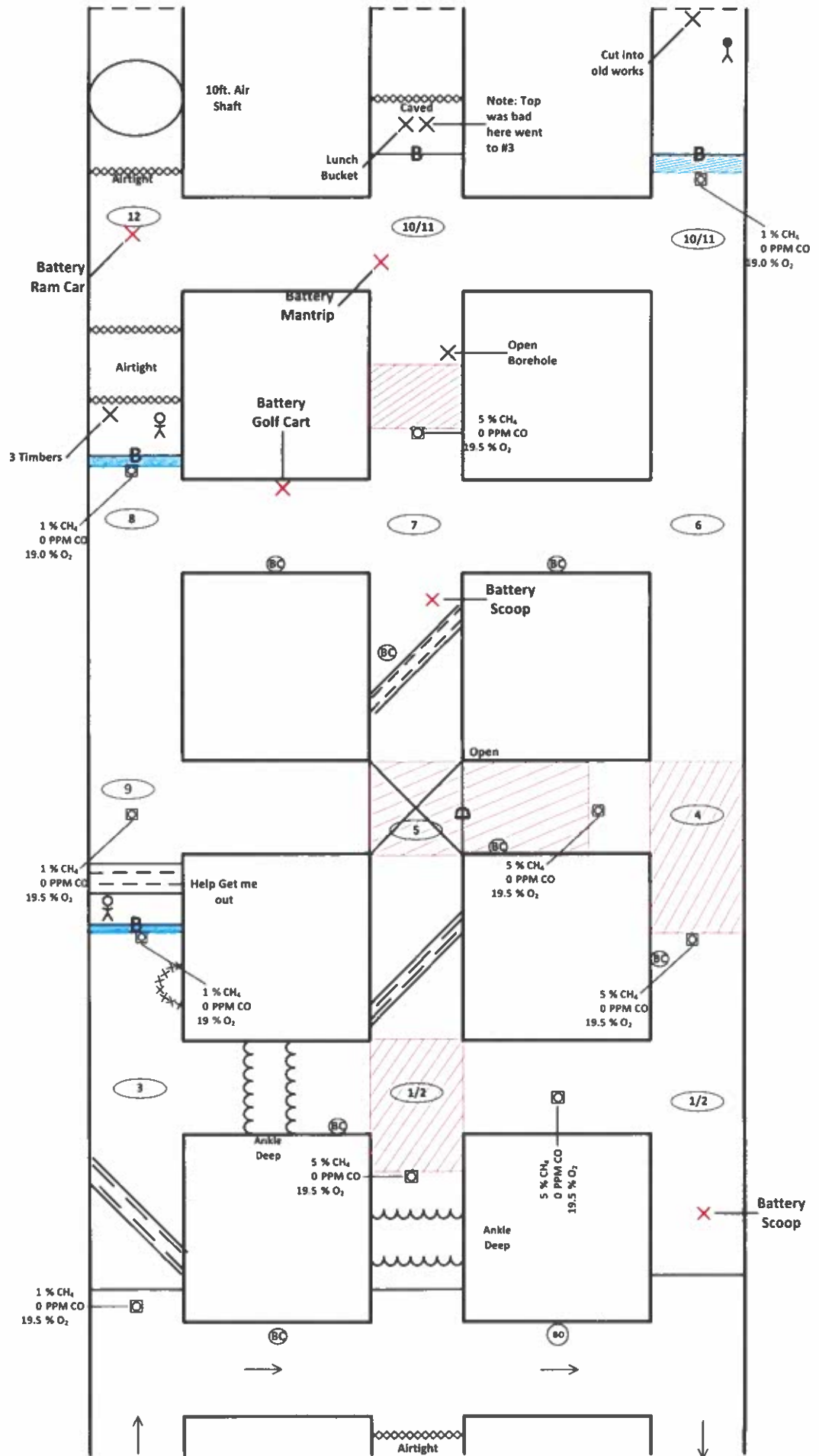
**ACCOUNT FOR ALL MISSING MINERS AND BRING SURVIVORS TO THE FRESH AIR BASE.**

**THE EXHAUST FAN IS RUNNING AND CANNOT BE STOPPED, STALLED OR REVERSED. INTAKE ENTERS THE #1 ENTRY AND RETURNS OUT THE #3 ENTRY. THERE IS A 10FT. DIAMETER AIR SHAFT IN THE #1 ENTRY AT THE FACE THAT CAN BE USED FOR VENTILATION IF NEEDED.**

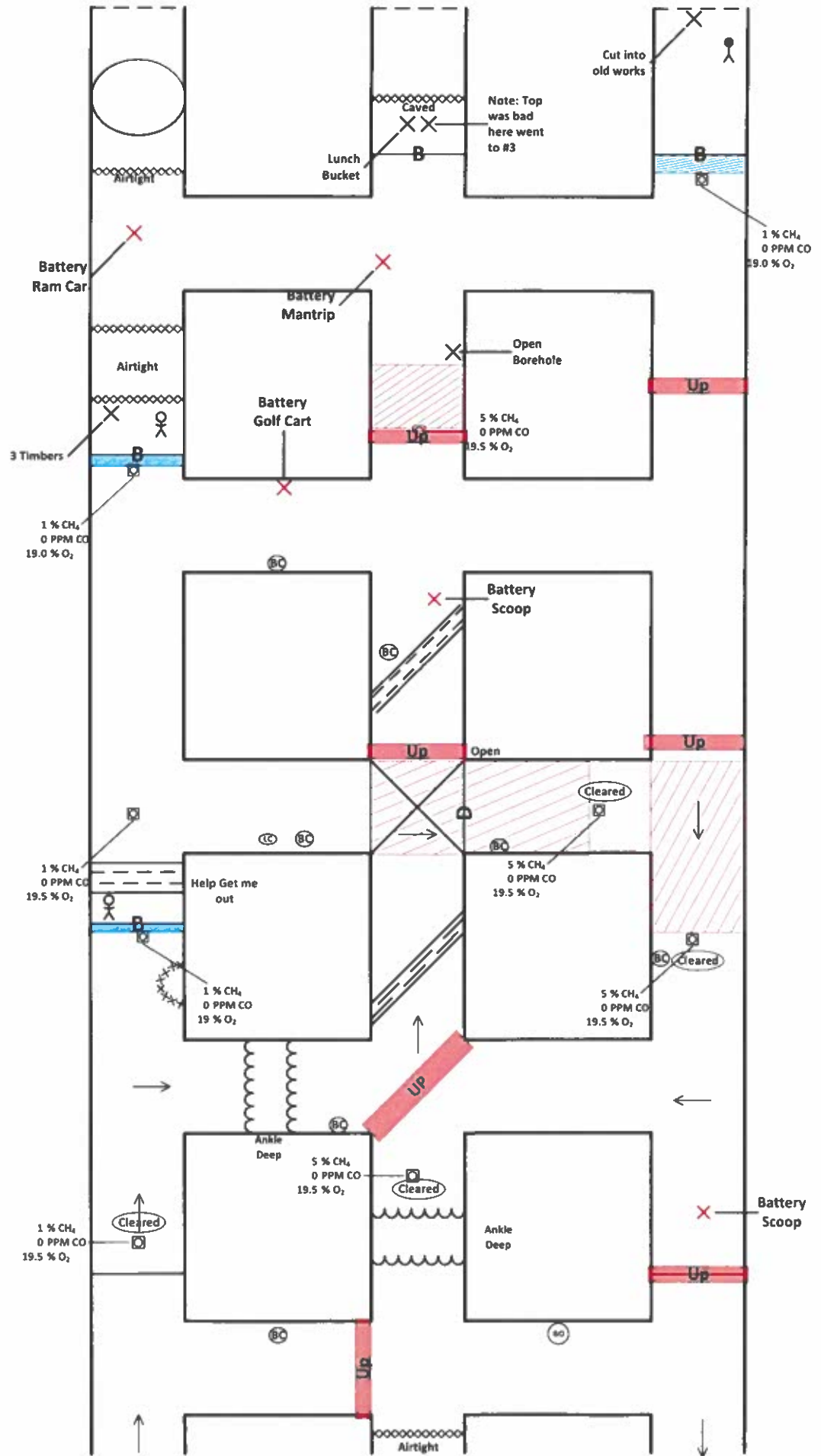
**TEAMS ARE LIMITED TO CARRY ONLY THREE BRATTICE CLOTHES WHILE TEAM IS TRAVELING.**

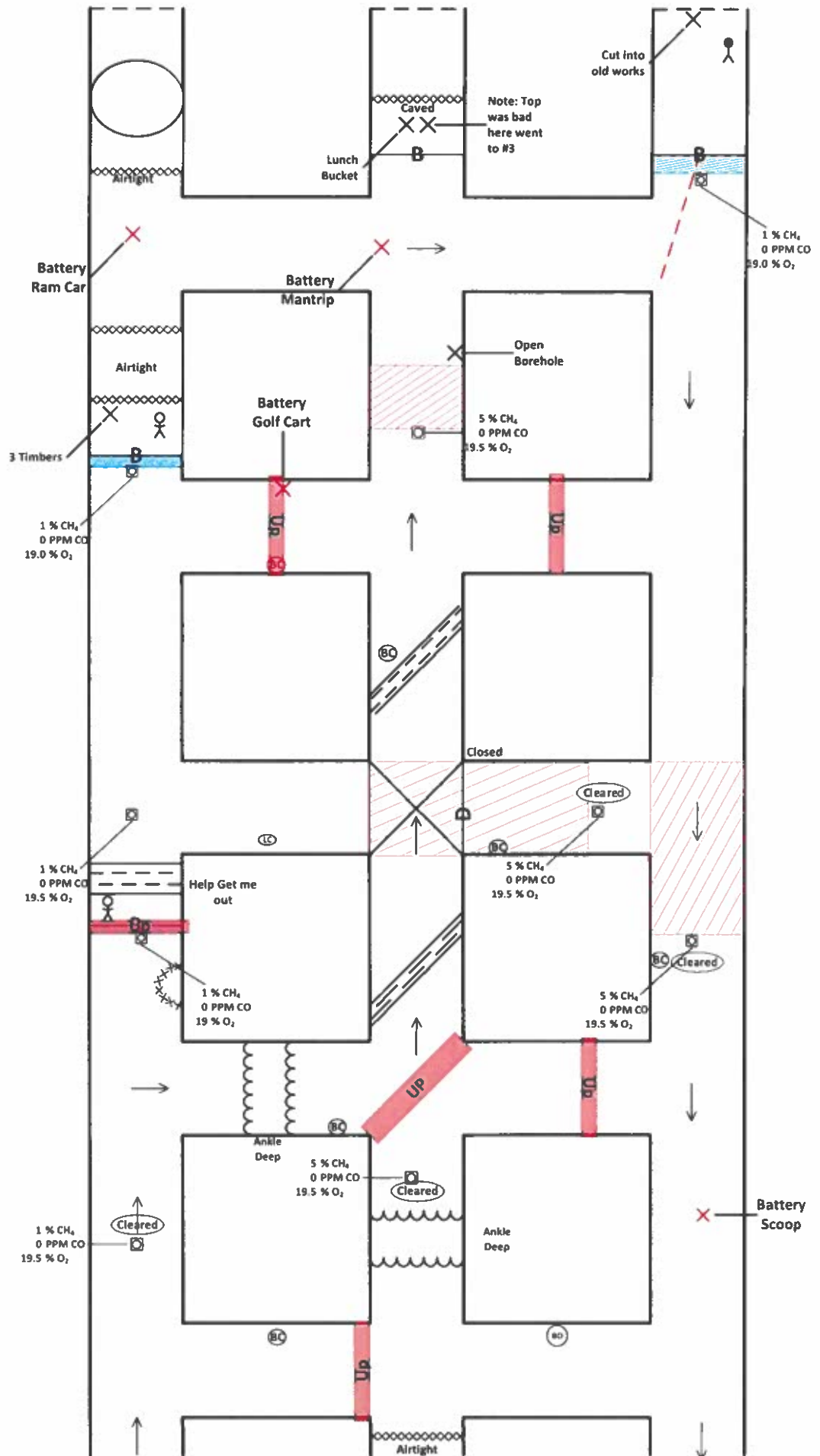
**3<sup>RD</sup>**
